DISCUSS

CREATE

Make an experience of your own.

- Make a cat mask out of a paper plate. What would you do all day?

IMAGINE

Use your imagination to explore.

- If you have a pet, imagine what they do during the day when you are gone. Draw or write a story about this.
- There are a lot of L words in this story. Luke, Lucy, lazy – find as many L words as you can and practice reading them aloud. Imagine what other L words you know!!
